Our award-winning Arts at the Airport program showcases the region's visual and performing arts throughout the terminal. We work closely with the 15-member Arts at the Airport Foundation Board to review and present works by local, regional and national artists for the enjoyment and enrichment of passengers and visitors, adding to the Nashville Airports Experience. In addition to visual arts, we host some of the best local talent that Music City has to offer. The Arts at the Airport program receives some funding from the Tennessee Arts Commission. One percent of nonfederal capital construction project funding goes to fund public art at Nashville International.

ART:

- Began in 1988
- Rotating public art exhibits and permanent acquisitions throughout our terminal
- Our offices house a large collection of original works, including 239 pieces in various styles and media including painting, sculpture, photography, printmaking and mixed media on paper by some of the state's most acclaimed artists.
- Permanent art piece in lobby and soon-to-be-installed permanent art piece in new consolidated rental car facility

MUSIC:

- Live music at the airport began in the 1990s and expanded in 2001.
