



Nashville International Airport Terminal Renovation

Phase I of the Nashville International Airport's Terminal Renovation Project, the first interior renovation of the existing terminal, was completed on time and under budget in January 2009. Additions included new food, beverage and retail vendors; a consolidated security checkpoint; new concourse skylights; and new flight information displays.

Phase II of the Nashville International Airport's Terminal Renovation Project began in August 2009 and is projected to be complete in 2011.

TERMINAL RENOVATION PHASE II HIGHLIGHTS

- Renovation of existing public restrooms and construction of new restrooms. Restrooms in the C concourse will be renovated first, and new restrooms will be added on the ground level and in the A concourse.
- Replacement of terminal and concourse carpeting and tile.
- Replacement of existing HVAC units.
- Renovation of airline gate hold rooms.
- Replacement of wall coverings on ticketing, baggage and ground transportation levels.
- Enlargement of ticket lobby.
- Renovation of baggage claim.
